Introduction: Conqueror – to be victorious to overcome by force.

Text: Romans 8:35 Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword?

36 As it is written, For thy sake we are killed all the day long; we are accounted as sheep for the slaughter.

37 Nay, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him that loved us.

Other Translations - Romans 8:37 Yet amid all these things we are more than conquerors and gain a surpassing victory through Him Who loved us. (AMP)

Four absolutes if you are truly going to be more than a conqueror

1. Must Be Throughly Convinced God Is On Your Side

God is for us

Romans 8:31What shall we then say to these things? If God be for us, who can be against us?

God is on our side

Psalm 118:6 The LORD is on my side; I will not fear: what can man do unto me?

I activate the presence of God by the use of HIS name

Psalm 124:1 If it had not been the LORD who was on our side, now may Israel say; 2 If it had not been the LORD who was on our side, when men rose up against us: 3 Then they had swallowed us up quick, when their wrath was kindled against us: 4 Then the waters had overwhelmed us, the stream had gone over our soul: 5 Then the proud waters had gone over our soul. 6 Blessed be the LORD, who hath not given us as a prey to their teeth. 7 Our soul is escaped as a bird out of the snare of the fowlers: the snare is broken, and we are escaped. 8 Our help is in the name of the LORD, who made heaven and earth.

Whatever you have need of the Name will take care of it

John 14:12 Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father.

13 And whatsoever ye shall ask in my name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son.

14 If ye shall ask any thing in my name, I will do it.

2. Must Know That Satan Is Limited

The devil lies because he can't make you do it any other way

John 8:44 Ye are of your father the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it.

The devil deceives because he can't make you do it any other way

Revelation 12:9 And the great dragon was cast out, that old serpent, called the Devil, and Satan, which deceiveth the whole world: he was cast out into the earth, and his angels were cast out with him.

We are delivered from the devil's power

Colossians 1:12 Giving thanks unto the Father, which hath made us meet to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in light:

13 Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated us into the kingdom of his dear Son:

The devil is not over you he is under your feet

Ephesians 1:19 And what is the exceeding greatness of his power to us-ward who believe, according to the working of his mighty power,

20 Which he wrought in Christ, when he raised him from the dead, and set him at his own right hand in the heavenly places,

21 Far above all principality, and power, and might, and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this world, but also in that which is to come:

22 And hath put all things under his feet, and gave him to be the head over all things to the church,

23 Which is his body, the fulness of him that filleth all in all.

You have the power to cast the devil out

Mark 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;

You have the power to bind the devil

Matthew 18:18 Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.

3. Must Surround Yourself With Believers

There is great power in the agreement of believers

Matthew 18:19 Again I say unto you, That if two of you shall agree on earth as touching any thing that they shall ask, it shall be done for them of my Father which is in heaven.

Believers will exhort and lift up each other

Hebrews 10:24 And let us consider one another to provoke unto love and to good works:

25 Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is; but exhorting one another: and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching.

Make it a point to keep company with believers

Proverbs 13:20 He that walketh with wise men shall be wise: but a companion of fools shall be destroyed.

The knowledge of God is in and from believers

Proverbs 9:10 The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom: and the knowledge of the holy is understanding.

Stay away from those who do not believe in God – they are fools

Psalm 14:1 The fool hath said in his heart, There is no God. They are corrupt, they have done abominable works, there is none that doeth good.

4. Accept A Bible Picture Of Yourself

You will become what you think of yourself

Proverbs 23:7 For as he thinketh in his heart, so is he: Eat and drink, saith he to thee; but his heart is not with thee.

Paul was made righteous

2 Corinthians 5:21 For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him.

Paul use to be a murder but because of his righteous picture of himself he said he had defrauded no man.

2 Corinthians 7:2 Receive us; we have wronged no man, we have corrupted no man, we have defrauded no man.

Paul said he was a patter to you and I

1 Timothy 1:16 Howbeit for this cause I obtained mercy, that in me first Jesus Christ might shew forth all longsuffering, for a pattern to them which should hereafter believe on him to life everlasting.

Paul said he could do all things

Philippians 4:13 I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me.

Paul said he was more than a conqueror

Romans 8:37 Nay, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him that loved us.

Romans 8:31 What, then, shall we say in response to this? If God is for us, who can be against us?

1 Corinthians 15:57 But thanks be to God, which giveth us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.
